

a feast that consists of roast pheasant or braised venison is served. From 150 to 400 persons can be accommodated at £5-£10 (\$9-\$18) a head.

The grounds at Knebworth House provide an exquisite setting for an Edwardian garden party during the summer months. Guests are entertained by a brass band and country dancers. They dine on cucumber sandwiches, asparagus rolls, sweets, and fresh strawberries. Knebworth House can accommodate 200-500 on the lawn. Price varies with menu, depending upon whether it is an afternoon tea or a buffet luncheon. The range is from £5 to £15 (\$9-\$27) per head.

Leeds Castle in Kent, an hour-and-a-half's train ride from London to Bearsted or a 40-mile coach ride, gained popularity recently after it was used for part of the Arab-Israeli peace talks. Lady Bailey bought the castle and restored it. The Leeds Castle Foundation now owns it since her death four years ago. It is an elegant private house that has 21 bedrooms and that sleeps 30 guests. Small groups can stay there for three or four days. The service and food is impeccable. Swimming, tennis, golf, and croquet are available on the grounds. It is a relaxing atmosphere with tight security. Rates range from £60 to £200 per person per day (\$120-\$400).

Leeds Castle is an excellent location for a women's luncheon. Guests are given coffee upon arrival and then a tour during which they can see housekeepers changing sheets and cleaning the fireplace. This brings the castle alive. A superb lunch follows in the plush library. The staff is friendly and courteous and has been at the castle long enough to entertain with their share of ghost stories. The cost is about £50 per person (\$100) plus transportation.

Candlelight dinners can be held in the medieval part of the castle for a maximum of 70 guests.

Any function at Leeds Castle, whether an entire weekend or only a lunch, is a totally delightful experience. Since the castle is now a charity, some companies make a donation to the foundation and then use the castle tax-free for weekends.
